- Degree in Social Work; or an associated qualification
- Demonstrated experience in program leadership & supporting clients with complex and diverse needs.
- Ability to maintain positive professional relationships with stakeholders, clients and staff.
- Highly developed communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to work unsupervised.
- Current drivers licence
- Current First Aid certificate, or willingness to obtain
- National Police check is required for all roles at LCM.
- Working with Vulnerable People Check, or willingness to obtain.

Desirable Qualifications/Experience:

- Experience or demonstrated capacity to work in an organisation adopting a Christian ethos.
- Experience in business management.
- Ability to manage diverse workforce, including volunteers.
- Positive history of following organisational Policy & Procedures.

Morton's Place is a drop-in centre for individual and groups offering support and social inclusion in the heart of Launceston; the cohort includes those dealing with homelessness, mental health challenges, life controlling addictions and other disadvantage. The program offers breakfast and lunch, laundry, and shower facilities five days a week.

Primarily the Team Leader Morton's Place will be responsible for the management and supervision of Morton's Place Day Centre, it's programs, and associated staff of paid and volunteer workers.

This is a Full-time position (38 hours per week) and salary will be based on the Social, Community, Home Care and Disability Services Industry Award 2010. Community Service Salary Packaging applies.
