- Workplace level 2 First Aid certificate
- Current drivers' licence
- National Police check,
- Working with Vulnerable People Card

Selection Criteria (Desirable Qualifications/Experience):

- Experience or demonstrated capacity to work in an organisation adopting a Christian ethos.
- Experience in running youth and/or community outreach events in cooperation with other community-based services, organisations and/or stakeholders.
- Highly developed communication skills.
- Ability to manage, support and train teams of volunteers to effectively deliver outreach trailer programs.
