City Mission is seeking a qualified, experienced, and highly motivated Supervisor Youth and Futures to join The Mish and Mission2aFuture services at The Ark in Launceston. The successful candidate will have a flair for creative design and an eye for project management. They will work directly in program development with a focus on strategic planning, grant and report writing, and managing the WHS requirements of their services. The Supervisor Youth and Futures will also shape a positive team culture in line with City Mission's values and use their strong communication skills to build rapport with clients, staff, and all external stakeholders.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Essential Qualifications/Experience:

- Relevant tertiary qualifications in Social Work, Community Service or Ministry; or an associated qualification.
- Minimum 3 years' experience in a similar role.
- Demonstrated experience in leading a diverse workforce.
- Demonstrated experience in supporting clients with complex and diverse needs.
- Experience working in a multi-disciplinary team in a highly dynamic environment.
- Ability to develop and maintain positive professional relationships with stakeholders, clients, and staff.
- Highly developed administrative and communication skills.
- Demonstrated history of setting and applying good professional boundaries.
- Current drivers' licence.
- Current First Aid certificate, or willingness to obtain.
- National Police check is required for all roles at LCM.
- Working with Vulnerable People Check, or willingness to obtain.

Desirable Qualifications/Experience:

- Experience or demonstrated capacity to work in an organisation adopting a Christian ethos.
- Experience in working within a trauma-informed environment.
- Experience in team management.
- Experience in business management.
- Positive history of following organisational policy & procedures.
- Demonstrated time management skills.

The Mish is City Mission's Youth Service, supporting young people aged between 13 and 25 to grow in self-awareness, ambition, and resilience. It is the vision of LCM to see young people live lives of success and significance.

Mission 2 a Future (M2aF) is a unique mentoring program that focuses on a holistic approach in supporting vulnerable members of our community to make positive steps forward toward a brighter future. Participants aged 17 and above are supported by trained facilitators who walk beside them, providing them with life skills and opportunities to re-engage with the community, education, training and/or employment.



The Supervisor Youth and Futures is responsible for the leadership of The Mish and Mission2aFuture services. This includes the development and coordination of service programs, leading processes for the engagement and retention of participants, the organisation of external facilitators, liaising with stakeholders, managing the service's budget, and contributing to the overall strength and success of the Youth and Futures team.

This is a part-time position, and the salary will be based on the Social, Community, Home Care and Disability Services Industry Award 2010. As a Public Benevolent Institution, LCM employees are eligible to salary package through our approved provider.
